Scholarship Application for Graduating Seniors

The Camp Lejeune Officers' Spouses' Club awards scholarships to qualified seniors (graduating from high school, in the spring of 2020), based on academic excellence, merit and service. Since part of the OSC's mission is to use our time, talents and energy to enhance the Camp Lejeune community, we award students who are doing the same for their communities.

Eligibility

The applicant's sponsor (of ANY military rank or service) must meet one of the criteria below:

1. Active duty military personnel assigned to MCB Camp Lejeune, a tenant unit aboard Camp Lejeune, Camp Johnson, Camp Geiger, or MCAS New River.
2. Deceased military personnel whose last active duty station was one of the above locations.

Qualifications

The applicant must:

- Be applying for full-time admission to an accredited two or four year college/university.
- Have an unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Properly complete the application and include all supporting documents. Incomplete, incorrectly completed, or late applications will not be considered.

Scholarship checks will be made payable to the college/university in the student's name and must be used for tuition, books, or housing. If the applicant is receiving scholarships or other financial aid for college expenses, they may still apply for an OSC Scholarship if they have additional costs (housing, books, etc.) that must be directly paid to the college/university/academy. Applicants who receive other scholarships/financial aid equal to or greater than their first year's tuition, housing and books will forfeit their OSC Scholarship and an alternate recipient will then be awarded.

**All application components (transcripts, military orders)
must be postmarked by March 31, 2020.**

Essay Instructions

The applicant must submit one essay. The essay must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-pt Times New Roman font with 1 inch margins. The essay should be a minimum of 350 words, and not exceed 500 words. **Essays that do not follow the instructions or are plagiarized will not be accepted.** Essays will be scored based on content, authenticity, cohesion, organization, and mechanics. **DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME ANYWHERE IN YOUR ESSAYS.**

Pick 1 essay topic from below and write your 350-500 word essay following the guidelines from above.

- a. Let's go back in time when learning was pure joy. Tell us about your favorite childhood book, and why.
- b. You are required to spend the next year in either the past or future. What year would you travel to, and why?
