SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR
Spouses

The Camp Lejeune Officers' Spouses' Club awards scholarships to qualified military spouses based on outstanding merit. Since part of the OSC's mission is to use our time, talents and energy to enhance the Camp Lejeune community, we award spouses who are doing the same for their communities. The OSC Scholarship Committee selects the recipients and the Committee's judgment is final.

Eligibility

The applicant's sponsor (of ANY military rank or service) must meet one of the following criteria:

1. Active duty military personnel assigned to Camp Lejeune.
2. Active duty personnel currently fulfilling an unaccompanied PCS tour whose last duty station was Camp Lejeune.
3. Retired or deceased military personnel whose last active duty station was in the Camp Lejeune area (MCB Camp Lejeune, MCAS New River, MCAS Cherry Point).

Qualifications

The applicant must ...

- Be applying for or currently pursuing an undergraduate, graduate or a certification degree/program at an accredited two or four year college/university, part or full-time.
- Properly complete the application and include all supporting documents. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Scholarship checks will be made payable to the college/university in the student's name and must be used for tuition, academic fees, books or housing. If the applicant is receiving scholarships or other financial aid for college expenses, they may still apply for an OSC Scholarship if they have additional costs (housing, books, etc.) that must be directly paid to the college/university. Applicants that receive other scholarships/financial aids equal to or greater than their first years' tuition, academic fees, housing and books will forfeit their OSC scholarship and an alternate recipient will then be awarded.

All applications must be post-marked by March 5th, 2018.

Spouse Application Checklist

- Completed Applicant Acknowledgement (page 2).
- Completed Applicant, Sponsor, Education, and Service/Activities sections (pages 3 – 7).
- Official high school or college transcript included.
- Copy of sponsor's orders or retirement papers included.
- Typed essay included. Do NOT include your name anywhere on the essay page.
- One letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member (i.e. teacher, counselor, employer, etc.) included. They must give their name, relation to the applicant, address, and phone number and place the letter in a sealed envelope to be included with this application.

Essay Instructions

The applicant must submit one essay. The essay must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-pt Times New Roman font with 1 inch margins. It should be 250 – 350 words in length. Essays that do not follow the instructions or are plagiarized will not be accepted. **DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME ANYWHERE IN YOUR ESSAY.**

The applicant's response to the essay question will be compared to others applying for scholarships. Essays will be scored based on cohesion, logic, content, organization, spelling, and grammar.

Members of the Camp Lejeune OSC use their time, talents and energy to enhance the Camp Lejeune community. What are your future goals and how do you see yourself giving back to your community?
